NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- This trial is being held under the UK Agility International (UKI) rules.
- Competitors, through the submission of entry, acknowledge that they know the UKI Agility rules. https://www.ukicanada.com
- All dogs and handlers must be registered with the UKI in order to compete. https://www.ukagilityinternational.com/DynamicContent.aspx?PageName=cadreg
- Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UK Agility International Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speedstakes.

- Payment can be made by electronic transfer to info@guidescanins.com with the answer to the question your dog's name in all small letters without spaces, without accent. You can do only one transfer for all your registration for all your dogs. You can also pay by credit card. An invoice will be sent to you by email. Payment must be made promptly after receipt of the invoice. Registration will be valid only after receipt of payment.
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Entries close automatically when the limit has been reach or at the date stated whichever comes first.
- The classes cost \$15.50+tx (17.83). \$33+tx (37.94) for the Master Series. before the closing date.
- NFC (Not for Competition) entries accepted (but not for the Master Series), \$11+tx (12.85)/class.
- It will be possible to register on site, if there is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$20+tx (23). \$41+tx (47.14) for the Master Series, \$15+tx (17.25) NFC.
- All obstacles will conform to UKI specifications.
- All contact obstacles and tables are rubberized.
- All single jumps have wings, plastic strip cups and are not attached.
- All tunnels are antislip.
- An electronic timer will be used for all the events, in all the rings.
- Same day move up accepted.

- Bitches in season are allowed to run at this show. You must notify the show secretary as early as
 possible to this fact. All Bitches in season must run at the end of the class, after all jump heights
 have finished in that class and must use a mat on the start line, to be provided by the show. In
 season pants may be worn while running but handlers allow this at their own risk.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.
- The running orders will be sent by email.
- The course maps will be sent by email two hours before the Trial starts and will be posted on site.
- The results will only be posted on site and sent by email at the end of the day.
- The ribbons will be available on a self-service basis.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants cancelling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for dogs and handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours of the start of the first day they are registerd.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.
- A \$20 fees will be charged for NSF checks and refused credit cards.

- Refund policy if you register with the UKI directly: Entries will not be accepted, changed or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the creation of the account date. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UK Agility International account. If money is to be returned then the following administration costs will be incurred. If payment was received by check or money order then a \$4 administration fee will be incurred. If payment was received by credit card a 4% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. If payment was received from a Pay Pal account, a 5% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. Once a show has been closed and/or capped refunds of any kind for any reason will not be available. A partial entry may be available for injuries where a veterinarian note is provided. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.

- Speedstakes Titling Program
 - <u>SS Beginners:</u> For dogs that are not eligible for SS Novice, SS Senior and SS Champion levels in the Speedstakes Program.
 - <u>SS Novice</u>: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points in the SS Beginners classes or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.
 - <u>SS Senior</u>: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the SS Novice classes.
 SS Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points in the SS Senior classes.
 - SS Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points in the SS Senior classes.
- International Titling Program
 - Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for Novice, Senior and Champion levels in the International Program.
 - Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points, where 8 of those points must be obtained in agility classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.

- Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the Novice classes, where
 12 of those points must be obtained in agility classes, 4 from jumping, and 4 from games.
- Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points, where 12 of those points must be obtained in agility classes, 12 from jumping, and 12 from games.

Dogs are measured while in a standing position on a flat surface. The measurement is taken from the top of the dog's withers. All dogs, except the 24 & 22 inch divisions and the 20inch Select, must have an official measurement when at their first show. If your official dog's measurement moves you into a different height than the one entered, you must notify the show secretary and your dog will be moved into the correct height.

*Based on highest STANDARD Agility level at time of Handler UKI registration. After this time, All new dogs that have not competed at any listed organization at time of UKI registration are only eligible for Beginners unless that handler is currently competing with a International Program Champ level dog under their account, then the dog must start in Novice. All new dogs registered after Handler registration may only transfer at the level they were competing at on the date of the Handler registration. Once a dog is registered with UKI, then no other organizations results have bearing on the dog's level with UKI.

Country Selection 2022 | World Agility Open

- Canadian Masters Series Tournement Rules
 - The aim of the Masters is to encourage more competitive running in UKI classes and improve the overall standard of top level agility. The Masters has been created for dogs and competitors whose goal is to compete at both National and International level.
 - The Masters is considered one class made up of 2 rounds: an Agility and Jumping round with results combined.
 - Entry open to ALL dogs of all levels.
 - Separate competition for each jump height.
 - Running order for second round will be in reverse order of the first runs results. If a handler has 2 dogs entered within a jump height, they may move their first dog up so that there are as many dogs as possible between their dogs. If this is not possible, they will receive a 6 minute break. If a handler has more than 2 dogs within a jump height and the entry is not large enough for a large enough gap in between all their dogs, the first of their dogs drawn will be allowed to run in between a jump height change, if a jump height change is available before their height. If it is not, the final decision will be made by the judge and show manager, taking into consideration fairness to the competitor and other entrants in the Masters Class. Day of Entries must run first within the running orders of the first class. The second class must run in reverse order of placing from first class. Handlers must run for competition in both rounds to receive a combined score and be eligible for the Final, awards & prizes. The dog must run in the height that he will compete at in the Master's Final. The same dog and handler must run both rounds. Any extraordinary circumstances to be ruled by UKI.
 - Cumulative scoring; dog with the lowest score wins. Faults converted into seconds (5 faults = 5 seconds) and time faults treated the same as course faults but converted on a 1:1 ratio.
 - Winners in each height of the Agility round and the Jumping round qualify for the Masters Series Final.
 - If 1-5 dogs are entered in a jump height 1st 8 2nd place from the combined scores of Agility and Jumping rounds qualify for the Masters Series Final. If 6 – 10 dogs are entered in a jump height 1st - 3rd will qualify, above 10; 1st – 4th will qualify.
 - Prize money to be paid out to at each heat for the combined winners per the prize fund below. In the event of a tie for the combined results, the result from the Agility round will be the deciding factor. If there is still a tie, the dogs will compete in a run-off on the 2nd rounds course.
 - o Eliminations will result in 100 faults with a 60-second course time.
 - Dogs that score 320 cumulative and over will not be placed nor awarded prize money.
 A no-show in either class will result in a disqualification from the class and therefore will not be eligible individual class placement, overall placement or eligibility to qualify for the Final.

SPECIAL RULES TO MITIGATE CONTAGION RISKS OF COVID-19
