LOCATION AND SPECIFICATIONS

- This test will be held at GUIDES CANINS 1200A montée Poirier, Saint-Lazare, indoors, in an 80' X 120', on a synthetic turf surface equipped with an underlay.

- It will be held according to the regulations and sanctioned by the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC).
- All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- The Contact obstacles are Galican Soft Line and tunnels are Galican Fullgrip.
- A wall and a broad jump can be used in all the courses and levels.
- An electronic timer will be used for all the events.

ELIGIBILITY

- All dogs (pure breed, unrecognized beed, mixed breed) must be individually registered with the CKC or eligible for CKC registration.
- Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number (ERN).
 This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the award/titles earned, the non-member will have the choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only for dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

REGISTRATION, FEES & PAYMENTS

- Competitors, through the submission of entries, acknowledge that they know the CKC rules. www.ckc.ca.
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- Agility Rocks! registrations open 1 month before the first day of the event.
- Registrations close at 11:59 p.m. 2 Mondays before the event or when the limit is reached.
- If the registration limit is reached before the closing date, a waiting list will be established.
- The classes cost \$22,50+tx before the closing date.
- PRE REGISTRATION SPECIAL! 5 runs same dog -10%.
- It will be possible to register after the closing date or on site before the courses are published, if there
 is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$27+tx.

- DO NOT PAY WHEN YOU REGISTER ON AGILITY ROCKS! WAIT FOR THE INVOICE. An invoice will be sent to you by email. Payment must be made promptly upon receipt of this invoice. Registration will be valid only after receipt of payment.
- Payment can be made by electronic transfer to info@guidescanins.com with the answer to the
 question: your dog's name in all small letters without spaces, without accent or by credit card directly
 from your portal.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants canceling before the closing date will obtain a refund.
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs and/or handlers that are injured, providing that they send a doctor or a veterinarian note and that the trial secretary is advised at least 24 hours before the time of the registration of the first day of the test.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.

PROCEDURE

- A confirmation email will be sent on the Wednesday after the closing date.
- An email with general instructions and running orders will be sent the Wednesday before the event.
- The course maps will be sent by email two hours before the test starts and will be posted on site.
- Dogs who have earned a title may advance to a higher level provided that the secretary is notified in writing (you have to fill out a move up form) as soon as the results are published or before the end of the day.
- Same day move ups are accepted.
- The results will be posted on site and sent by email at the end of the day.
- In all classes, rosettes from 1st to 4th place for dogs with qualifying scores in each division and height category.
- The position rosettes and qualifying ribbons will be available on a self-service basis.
- Title ribbons will be prepared according to the Title Form.

CLEANLINESS POLICY

- You must bring clean shoes and change them before entering the room.
- Soiled shoes or boots must be left outside the room.
- An 'OOPS' fee of \$10 per incident will automatically be billed to the account of the owner of a dog who
 urinates, marks, defecates, vomits or bleeds in the room.
- It is forbidden to consume food, gum or drinks (other than water) in the room.
- Please empty the remainder of your dog's water bowl into the water bowl, sinks, toilets or outside the building and please do not pour it onto the agility room mat.

- ATTENTION U.S. Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to the constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however they are payable in Canadian funds. If you send a check in US funds, it must be made out of the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.
